

## WIRELESS INTERNET POLICIES

- All persons accessing the Wireless Internet via the Library must comply with the current McKenzie Memorial Public Library Policies for the Internet use.
- Access points to the Internet are provided by the Library free of charge to patrons with the appropriate computers receiving the signal provided (802.11b/g).
- The Library Wireless connection is unencrypted and unfiltered. In compliance with the Children's Internet Protection Act, the Library users under the age of 17 cannot access the Internet using the wireless connection.
- Use of the Library wireless connection is done at the patron's own risk. Information sent to and from your computer using the wireless connection can be captured by anyone else using the wireless device and the appropriate software.
- The Library staff cannot configure users' computers, since everyone's device is different. The Library cannot accept the liability of handling the equipment.
- The Library is not responsible for any changes made to your settings to access the wireless network.
- Printing is not available via the wireless connection.
- The Library is not responsible for any equipment left unattended in the library.
- Access to the Wireless connection can only be done in the reception area, on the Main floor of the Library.
